



GENERAL CAMPUS INFORMATION

CHECK-IN AT THE INTERNATIONAL CENTER

The UCSD International Center is the department of record for the U.S. Immigration and Naturalization Service for all international students and scholars at UCSD. **It is mandatory that international students and scholars check in at the International Center as soon as possible after arrival in San Diego.** Please bring your passport and I-20, or DS-2019 (formerly IAP-66), and complete a check-in form.

UCSD TRITON PHOTO ID CARDS

It is important that you apply for an ID immediately. ID pictures are taken every day, Monday through Friday, from 8:00am-4:30pm. (Hours may change during the summer.) The office is located in Student Account and University Billing Services (SAUBS) at 201 University Center, on Myers Drive across from the Registrar's Office. The ID cards are available within a few minutes after the pictures are taken. Phone: (858) 534-4322.

- **Post Docs, Visiting Scholars and Faculty:** Ask your department administrator for the ID card request form(s). Take it with you to Student Account and University Billing Services (SAUBS) for processing.
- **Graduate Students:** Contact your department.
- **Undergraduate Students:** ID pictures will be taken as part of your college orientation program. If you missed Orientation, contact your college first, and then go to Student Account and University Billing Services (SAUBS) at 201 University Center during business hours to obtain the UCSD Triton ID Card.
- **Spouses of Scholars and Students:** An affiliate ID card is available to spouses of visiting scholars and students (for bus passes, library cards, etc.) The spouse must present the valid ID card of the UCSD student or scholar, an affiliate ID form signed by the UCSD student or scholar, a passport or driver's license AND a marriage certificate or letter stating that the spouse is accompanying the student or scholar. The spouse needs to go first to the Cashier's Office to pay the \$15.00 fee and then bring the receipt to Student Account and University Billing Services (SAUBS).

TO REGISTER FOR CLASSES

- **Undergraduates:** You will enroll in classes at your college orientation. It is unnecessary to visit your college academic advisor prior to the designated orientation time.
- **Graduate Students:** See your academic department contact person.

E-MAIL (ELECTRONIC MAIL) ACCOUNTS

Every UCSD student/scholar is assigned a UCSD account which provides you with free e-mail access. Upon arrival at UCSD, you will need to activate your account in order to use it. You may either go in person to the Academic Computing Services (ACS), located in the Applied Physics & Mathematics building (AP&M), room 2113, or you may follow the detailed instructions on the ACS web site:
